For an Image, Faster than Light 9 Sept - 18 Dec 2016 Curator: Bose Krishnamachari. 74 artists from 33 countries.

30% of the participating artists were women artists. Works were also specially commissioned using local sites or materials. This was the opening exhibition for a new museum, without precedent in the region.

Yinchuan MOCA is outside Yinchuan, a city in China's northwestern region alongside the Yellow River, and one of the key cities on the Silk Road currently undergoing substantial redevelopment as part of China's new economic plan. The Museum is a private institution led by two women: founder and Director, Liu Wenjin, whose collection of Asian art is also on display and Artistic Director, Suchan Hsieh. The eco-site also houses an International Artist's Village.
